Key:

- 1) In Sections A & B graves were originally sold in groups of 3 per lot. Today graves are sold individually in these sections, but are still identified as 3 graves per lot.
- 2) Also in Sections A & B each row except row 12 is actually a double row with odd numbered lots in one row and even numbered lots in the other row. Row 12 is a single row containing all lots sequentially.
- 3) In all rows in Section C are single rows, but with only one grave per lot.
- 4) Section B, row 18, graves 1-8 are actually contained within two mausoleums.
